

INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF OYSTER BAY COVE
PROPOSED LOCAL LAW B-2022
AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 211
“NOISE”

A local law to add new Chapter 211, “*Noise*” to the Code of the Village. The Code was adopted by Local Law 6-2006 on April 11, 2006, by the Board of Trustees and last amended by Local Law 1-2022, adopted by the Board on February 7, 2022

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Oyster Bay Cove, as follows:

SECTION I. Amend Chapter 211, “*Noise*,” in part, to read as follows:

...

§ 211-9 Landscaping equipment.

Landscaping equipment, including but not limited to gas and electric powered leaf blowers and lawnmowers, chain saws and power washing equipment, which emits a noise audible beyond the boundary of the property upon which it is operated may be operated in the Village as follows:

A. Permitted hours of Operation for Landscaping:

Property Owner Landscaping

May 1- Sept 30

Monday through Friday: 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Saturday: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Sunday or Federal holiday: Prohibited

Oct 1 – April 30

Monday through Friday: 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Saturday & Sunday: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Federal holiday: Prohibited

Commercial Landscaping

Entire Year

Monday through Friday: 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Saturday: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Sunday and Federal holiday: Prohibited

B. In the event of an emergency, the Mayor, the Building Inspector, or the Village Chief of Police, or the designated representative of the Mayor, may grant an exemption from the provisions of this section. Such exemption should be in writing, but may be oral if the emergency is too urgent to allow sufficient time to prepare a written exemption. Each exemption granted pursuant to this subsection shall have a duration no longer than the emergency which is the basis for its issuance.

SECTION II. This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
