Dear Resident:

As the current fiscal year closes, highlights of the year include new contracts for the PBA and Chief as well as a new Village Office at 68 West Main Street in the Hamlet. Grant applications yielded \$152,000 this year. The most recent Grant, totaling \$50,000, will be used to enhance the Village's energy efficiency. The energy grant and use project is being overseen by Deputy Mayor Charlie Goulding. Attractive new LED lighting will be installed along the Village Historic Byways. We expect all grant projects to be completed over the next nine months with reimbursement to follow from the granting agencies.

The adopted Budget for the fiscal year ending May 31, 2018 totals \$5.9 million. The following table highlights essential services line items that comprise 85% of the Budget:
